Data Project

First of all, we wanted to update you on the results from our Data Project last year where we targeted 7th grade students who did not academically qualify for honor roll. Our goal was to have 15% of these students increase their overall GPA by .5 or achieve honor roll status from 1st to 3rd quarters. At the end of the year, we reached our goal with 18%.

This school year, we will be continuing to track and meet with these 8th graders. In addition, we will begin meeting with the new 7th graders and keeping our original goal of having 15% of the 7th graders, who do not qualify for honor roll after 1st quarter, increase their overall GPA by .5 or achieve honor roll status from 1st to 3rd quarters.
